

## Annehurst Village Pool Rules

### Admittance:

1. No child under the age of 7 years will be admitted to the pool unless accompanied by an adult, (i.e., a person who is 18 years or older);
2. The baby pool is to be used only by children that are too small for the main pool. Children are to be supervised by an adult or an approved babysitter. Management-approved babysitters may take children into the baby pool until 5 p.m.;
3. Management recognizes that in certain instances children are accompanied to the pool by babysitters. Management reserves the right to remove from the pool any babysitter who, in management's sole judgment and discretion, does not adequately supervise his/her wards. As a guideline for this rule, management suggests that babysitters be at least 16 years of age and also be accomplished swimmers. Parents who permit their children to attend the pool with a babysitter **MUST** designate the babysitter and the children who will be in his/her care on the pool registration form, and keep that registration current. Babysitters who come to the pool must have children in their care;
4. All children in the baby pool **MUST** be accompanied by an adult or responsible babysitter. This individual must remain in the baby pool enclosure while the child is in the pool;
5. After 5 pm, no child 11 years of age or under will be permitted at the pool without an adult;
6. A pool member shall be permitted to bring a guest to the pool for a fee of \$6.00 per day. **A group of ten or more guests requires prior approval by the pool manager. ANNEHURST, SPRING HOLLOW AND RIVER TRACE RESIDENTS WHO ARE NOT MEMBERS OF THE POOL MAY NOT BE ADMITTED AS GUESTS;**
7. No pets are allowed in the pool complex area;
8. People under the influence of alcohol or other drugs are not permitted in the pool complex;
9. Patrons are not permitted to visit a guard on duty.

### Pool Conduct:

1. Swimmers are not permitted in the water at any time unless a guard is on duty;
2. A 10-minute rest period must be taken each hour by those under 18 years of age. Adults only in the pool at rest period. Parents are permitted to take one small child in the pool during the rest break;
3. No swimming during electrical storms. Patrons will be asked to clear the pool area;
4. When the bell rings or requests are made to clear the pool, all swimmers are to move quickly to the nearest edge and get out of the water quickly;
5. No running on pool deck;
6. No standing in the gutter;
7. No back dives off the stainless gutter.
8. Patrons are not permitted to hang, climb or dive from the guard chairs.
9. Only staff members are allowed in the guard room and office.
10. Wrestling, dunking, chicken fights, shoving or throwing others into the pool are not permitted.
11. No hanging on the pool divider rope.
12. Swimmers will be permitted to swim in the deep end between the rope & the line painted on the deck.

### Food, Beverages, Alcohol:

1. All food and beverages must be consumed on the pool patio to the east of the pool office. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** are permitted on pool grounds during normal pool hours;
2. Food and drink are permitted in the concession area and grass area on east side of pool;
3. **NO GLASS CONTAINERS IN THE POOL COMPLEX;**
4. No smoking of any kind, chewing tobacco or dip in the pool complex.

**Equipment/Dress Code/Hygiene:**

1. No masks, snorkels or swim fins allowed;
2. Water wings, rafts and inner tubes are not allowed. Life Jackets are only allowed by reason of medical necessity. Only single foam noodles are permitted;
3. No diving rings unless used in swim lessons;
4. Toys are permitted in the baby pool only;
5. Soft nerf balls are permitted;
6. No rubber torpedoes;
7. Skates/Skateboards are not permitted in pool area;
8. All bicycles must be parked in the bike racks. No bikes should be parked along the fence on the north side;
9. Jeans, cut-offs or street clothes are not permitted to be worn in the pool;
10. No eyeglasses permitted in swimming pool;
11. People with bandages, sores, skin eruptions or open wounds are not permitted in the pool;
12. T-shirts MAY be worn in the pool.

**Diving Well:**

1. Forward dives only; no gainers, reverses, back dives, or inwards;
2. One bounce only on boards;
3. One person on diving boards at a time, no standing or waiting on the steps. People waiting must be on the ground;
4. No goggles or glasses permitted;
5. Must jump/dive straight off the boards, no jumping/diving off the side of board or towards the wall;
6. No catching anyone off the boards;
7. No lifejackets (unless with lessons);
8. Must swim to side immediately after diving;
9. If a diver hits the diving board during their dive from the buttocks up, please treat it a spinal rescue. Better safe than sorry;
10. Competitive diving not permitted;
11. Anyone using the diving boards must be able to swim two widths of the pool.

**Slide:**

1. Must be 48 in. to go down slide. No swim tests.
2. One rider at a time on slide
3. Must go feet first, facing forwards. No backwards or laying on your stomach riding.
4. No twisting, turning around while going down, you must stay sitting up or on your back. (Facing forwards)
5. No lifejackets, goggles, jewelry, or loose clothing (t-shirts) may be worn on the slide
6. NO catching is allowed
7. Wait till the rider has reached the bottom to send the next rider
8. Riders must exit immediately; no one is permitted to hang out on the stairs
