Egg Hunts...Two ways to have fun!

Annehurst "Neighborhood" Egg Hunt [self-led; one full week to search]

This is for ages 5+ (intended for older kids)

TASK: Identify Easter Egg signs in front yards.

WHEN: Hunt lasts 7 days beginning on Sat, April 1st (Dawn) through Sat, April 8th (11AM)

WHERE: Throughout the Annهورst Village Subdivision

PRIZE COLLECTION: April 8th, 11:00 a.m. at Annهورst Elementary School



Registered participants must find the Easter egg signs throughout our subdivision. Registered participants will be awarded under the rule of the "honor system" - we trust that what is verbalized is truthful.

THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE WILL BE AT THE END OF SUNDAY, MARCH 26th.

AN INFORMATIONAL EMAIL WILL GO OUT TO ALL REGISTERED PARTICIPANTS ON FRIDAY, March 1st.

- Once registered and via email, participants will be provided a list of locations (i.e. hiding spots) throughout the Annهورst Village Subdivision related to this event. In addition, information will be provided to registered participants on how, when and where prizes can be collected.
- Must be registered to win prizes.
- Registered participants must be current residents of the Annهورst Village Subdivision.
- Please stay on the sidewalks to hunt for the eggs. They will be visible from a distance.

- Make sure neighbors receive any neighborhood newsletters or other informational flyers that have been provided to or created by our Block Captain Committee.
